ITINERARY

Central Europe

11 Days - 9 Nights

DAY 1, April 20

Home City – Vienna

Depart from Calgary on your transpacific flight to Vienna.

DAY 2, April 21

Vienna

Upon arrival at Vienna airport board the coach and transfer to your 4-star hotel centrally located. Check in to your rooms and have some free time at leisure before dinner at hotel's restaurant. Overnight Vienna

DAY 3, April 22

Vienna

After breakfast depart for a guided city tour. Visit the Gothic St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Imperial Palace and the Art Nouveau splendour of the Succession.

The afternoon is at leisure.

Dinner and overnight Vienna

DAY 4, April 23

Vienna

After breakfast depart by private coach to Schonbrunn Palace (entrance included). This magnificent palace with its 1441 rooms and beautiful gardens is one of the most significant cultural monuments in Austria. Schonbrunn was the imperial summer palace during Maria Theresa's 40-year reign. It was here in the Hall of Mirrors that Mozart, aged 6, performed before the Empress and her court. In 1996 Schonbrunn Palace was listed as an UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site.

Return to Vienna for a free afternoon.

Dinner and overnight Vienna

DAY 5, April 24

Vienna - Budapest

Breakfast in hotel this morning transfer by coach to the train station and catch your train to Budapest. Upon arrival board the coach and transfer to your 4-star hotel centrally located. Check in to your rooms and have some free time at leisure.

Dinner and overnight Budapest

DAY 6, April 25

Budapest

After breakfast meet our local guide for a tour of Budapest, the capital city of Hungary. Budapest was formed in 1873 after the union of the three historic towns of Buda, Pest and Obuda. You'll visit the Castle District that features the famous St. Mathias Church (entrance included), located adjacent to the Fisherman's Bastion (entrance included). Built in 1905, the Bastion and its seven towers served as a fortress and now provide breathtaking views over the Danube, Margaret Island and Pest. The tour also includes the Hungarian Parliament, the second largest building in Europe, featuring 691 room, 20 km of corridors and a magnificent dome.

Dinner and overnight stay in Budapest

DAY 7, April 26

Budapest

Breakfast in hotel today is a day at your leisure to shop or explore more of this fascinating city. Possibilities include a visit to “Hero’s Square”, unwind on the beautiful Margaret Island, visit the famous Communist statue graveyard or simply relax for lunch in the open air piazza in Liszt Ference Ter, which is extremely popular with the locals.

Dinner and overnight stay in Budapest

DAY 8, April 27

Budapest - Prague

Breakfast in hotel then board the coach and transfer to the train station to catch your train to Prague. Upon arrival board the coach and transfer to your 4-star hotel centrally located. Check in to your rooms and have some free time at leisure.

Dinner and overnight Prague

DAY 9, April 28

Prague

After breakfast depart for a guided full day city tour. The first stop is Prague Castle (entrance included), the largest medieval castle in Europe built in the 9th century by Prince Borivoj. Then continue our tour to the Lesser Town that was founded in 1257 on the slopes below the Prague Castle. In the afternoon, enjoy a guided tour of the Old Town. The Church of Our Lady of Tyn and the Town Hall dominates the Old Town Square. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay in Prague.

DAY 10 April 29

Prague

Breakfast in hotel and then you will have a day at your leisure to shop or explore more of this fascinating city. Farewell dinner tonight.

Overnight Prague

DAY 11 April 30

Prague - Calgary

After breakfast in hotel board the coach and transfer to Prague’s airport for your return flight.
