CHINA 10 Days/8 Nights

FRIDAY, MARCH 25 Home City-Shanghai

DAY 01: Your journey begins with a morning flight to Vancouver to connect with your Air Canada Flight to Shanghai. Set your watch a day ahead as you cross the International Dateline.

SATURDAY, MARCH 26

DAY 02: Welcome to Shanghai, the legendary seaport and gateway to China. You will be met by your friendly guide and transferred to the Hotel. **(D)**

SUNDAY, MARCH 27

DAY 03: This morning you will go up to the **88th floor of Grand Hyatt Sky Deck** to have a bird's eye view of the City. Shanghai's Grand Hyatt is the 3rd tallest building in the World. Then off to the **Bund**, the famous promenade along the Huangpu River. Contrast the Old Colonial Shanghai on one side of the river with the skyscrapers of the modern Pūdōng District on the other. Lunch in a local restaurant. Then visit the 400 year old beautiful and peaceful **Yu Yuan Garden**, architecture gem of the Ming Dynasty (1368-1644). Dinner at a local restaurant. **(B/L/D)**

MONDAY, MARCH 28

DAY 04: This morning you will Visit **Shanghai Museum** and **French Concession area** to see old stone-walled house where locals still live. Lunch in a local restaurant. Visit a **Silk factory** to see how the silk is taken from the cocoon and spun into spools then made into fabrics. In the afternoon make an excursion to **Zhujiajiao Watertown** and have a gondola ride along the zigzag water alleys. Return to the downtown and enjoy a breathtaking **Acrobatic Show** in the evening. Dinner in a local restaurant. **(B/L/D)**

TUESDAY, MARCH 29 Shanghai-Xian by flight

DAY 05: Take morning flight to Xi'an. After lunch, have an excursion on Xian's **Old City Wall** where you will have a 1 hour exciting **bike tour** on top of the wall. In the evening, enjoy a **Tang Dynasty and Cultural Show** featuring music, dance, and traditional costumes complete with a **Dumpling Dinner**. **(B/L/D)**

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 30 Xian-Beijing by overnight train

DAY 06: Today's highlights include an exploration of China's cradle of civilization. Stand in awe at the most significant archeological excavations of the 20th century, the **Terra Cotta Warriors and Horses**, also a **World known UNESCO heritage site**. After the visit to the **museum and archeological site** you will have lunch in a local restaurant and then visit the Terra Cotta Manufacture plant to see the interesting process of terracotta warrior making in modern times. Return to downtown and spend some free time in the downtown Muslim Mosque Market. Dine in a

local restaurant before you board your overnight train to Beijing. (You will be in 4 couchettes to a room) **(B/L/D)**

THURSDAY, MARCH 31

DAY 07: This morning upon arrival in Beijing you will be transferred to the Hotel. You will have breakfast and start your day tour, first with a visit to the heart of Beijing, **Tiananmen Square**, which is the world's largest public square. Tiananmen Gate, also known as the "**Gate of Heavenly Peace**", is the entrance to the **Forbidden City**, 250 acres of palaces, pavilions, courtyards and gardens. Walk the hallways where 24 emperors of the Ming and Qing dynasties resided. Lunch at a restaurant and continue with a visit at an interesting Pearl Workshop. Afterwards, transfer to **Temple of Heaven** for a tour, where the emperor prayed for good harvests. Return to the hotel to check in.

FRIDAY, APR 01

DAY 08: This full day journey starts with a one and a half to two hours drive to **Mutianyu** site of **the Great Wall** where you take the chair lift up the Wall, visit, and toboggan down. Lunch in a local restaurant. After lunch, stop at a Jade Factory and see why China is famous for its Jade, continue to the **Spirit Way** to see vivid stone animal sculptures with great significance. **Western buffet dinner in a restaurant** followed by a fantastic **Chinese Kongfu Show**. **(B/L/D)**

SATURDAY, APR02

DAY 09: The morning after breakfast begins with the tour to the **Summer Palace**, the best-preserved and largest imperial garden in China. The palace is comprised of a complex of beautiful pavilions, halls and temples. Enjoy a lecture on Traditional Chinese painting and the art of Calligraphy inside the art gallery of the Summer Palace. After lunch, free time for you to do some shopping in the open market. Good opportunity to get some good quality knockoff. **Peking Roast Duck Dinner in a local restaurant**. **(B/L/D)**

SUNDAY, APR03

Beijing-Home City

DAY 10: This morning after breakfast you will take a **Hutong tour** by small Pedi-cabs and visit the ancient residential area of Beijing to witness the daily life of the local people. Join the local family with their home cuisine for lunch before you transfer to the airport. Board your Air Canada flight back home taking with you this wonderful cultural experience and memories of a life time.
