ITINERARY

Proposed
Spain & Morocco

Day 1, DEPARTURE April 19, 2011

Leave **Calgary's International Airport** via wide-bodied jet to **Spain**. Enjoy in-flight meals and services.

Day 2, MADRID April 20, 2011

Arrive into Madrid and be met by your RAINBOW EDUCATIONAL TOURS escort, taken to the hotel. Depending on the arrival time, free time until dinner, which will be served in a restaurant close to the hotel, return to the hotel for overnight.

Day 3, MADRID April 21, 2011

After breakfast, you will start a guided tour of the Capital of Spain, Madrid. You will see the famous Puerta del Sol, Paseo del Prado, Gran Vía and Plaza de España. You will visit the Royal Palace and, after the free lunch, the Prado Museum, the greatest Spanish and foreign art collection from the 12th to the 19th centuries in the country. Day 4, MADRID – TOLEDO - ESTEPONA April 22, 2011

Breakfast and departure to Toledo, one of the Spanish cities with the greatest wealth of monuments. It is known as the "city of the three cultures", because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived together there for centuries. After the guided visit, you will have free time for lunch and a stroll through the city. Departure for Estepona, arrival at the hotel, dinner and accommodation.

Day 5, ESTEPONA - TANGIER April 23, 2011

After breakfast you depart for Algeciras, where you will take the ferry across the Strait of Gibraltar towards Tangier. After the guided visit of Tangier you will have free time to discover the city. Return to the hotel for dinner and accommodation.

Day 6, TANGIER – CHAOEN - SEVILLE April 24, 2011

You will have breakfast and then depart for a full day excursion to Chaoen, one of the most beautiful cities of Morocco. Free time for lunch. Return to Tangier early enough to take the ferry back to Algeciras, from where you continue your tour to Seville. Arrival at the hotel, dinner + accommodation.

Day 7, SEVILLE April 25, 2011

After breakfast you will depart for a guided visit of the Capital of Andalusia, during which you will visit the biggest gothic Cathedral worldwide. Free time for lunch and for experiencing the Andalusian atmosphere in this inspiring city. Dinner and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 8, SEVILLE - GRANADA April 26, 2011

After breakfast you depart for Granada, where you will visit the famous Alhambra, one of the most beautiful Arab Palaces in the Western world, with a guide. The monument houses the Nazari Palaces, the Generalife gardens, a Royal residence, the Carlos V Palace and the Alcazaba fortress. Before the return to the hotel you will have free time to discover the city. Dinner + accommodation.

Day 9, GRANADA April 27, 2011

Breakfast. Today you will visit the city of Granada and its picturesque Moorish quarter, the Albaicín with its steep, narrow streets, beautiful nooks and crannies, and marvelous landscapes. The new part of the city is situated on the plain, crisscrossed by the large arteries of Gran Vía de Colón and Calle de los Reyes Católicos, and where the busy streets around the Cathedral are found. Free time for lunch and purchases before the return to the hotel for dinner + accommodation.

Day 10, GRANADA - CORDOBA April 28, 2011

Breakfast and departure for a guided visit of Cordoba including the Mosque - Cathedral, the only monument in the world bearing a Christian Cathedral built inside a Muslim Mosque, a testimony of the faith of both religions. Inside the monument we find the Orange Trees Courtyard with the ablution fountain. Then, a walk through the Judería (Jewish district) will take you to the Synagogue. Free time for lunch and further visits. Transfer to the hotel for dinner + accommodation.

Day 11, CORDOBA - MADRID April 29, 2011

Breakfast. Free time in the morning for last visits and purchases. After (free) lunch, departure for Madrid. Dinner at a centrally located restaurant and accommodation at the hotel.

Day 12, MADRID AND CALGARY April 30, 2011

After breakfast you will check-out of the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight home.
